Please note that UBP UK Online has been replaced by UBP e-Banking and UBP mobile. UBP UK Online remains available to view all data about your accounts produced before 30 November 2025. If you need to make a payment or view the current status of your account, please login to our new e-Banking solution, UBP e-Banking.

Access to UBP UK Online will cease after 27 February 2026. We strongly recommend downloading any documents produced before 28 November 2026 through UBP UK Online. If you require documents from this period after 27 February 2026, please contact your Relationship Manager.

Scope and Definitions

Throughout this Cookies Policy key words and expressions begin with a capitalised letter and are used with the defined meaning set out in Part 1 of the Banking and Investment Terms of Business ("Terms of Business"), including the Schedules (where relevant). A reference to Bank/we/us means Union Bancaire Privée (UK) Limited and any transferee, assignee or successor of Union Bancaire Privée (UK) Limited.

A reference to you/your/client refers to a person who has agreed to the Terms of Business.

Cookies Policy

This Cookies Policy explains our limited use of cookies and the information which is collected by the cookies in the provision of UBP UK Online. By using UBP UK Online you consent to the use of the cookies set out in this Cookies Policy. We only use cookies and the information obtained through them to deliver service functionality and to enhance the security of UBP UK Online: if you cease to use UBP UK Online we will not read the cookies or use the information obtained through them. However, the cookies cannot be disabled when you use UBP UK Online.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your computer or smart device when you visit a website or other internet enabled service. Cookies are then sent back to the originating web domain on your subsequent visits to that domain.

Cookies are useful because they allow a website or internet enabled service to recognise a user's smart device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and generally improve the user experience and for us to make UBP UK Online more secure.

Session cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser and persistent cookies remain on your computer or your smart device (that is, your smartphone, tablet or similar device) after the browser is closed (for example to remember your user preferences when you return to the site or service).

What types of cookies do we use?

The categories of cookies used in connection with our various products and services are listed below.

The cookies we use are stored on your computer when you use it to access UBP UK Online and are also stored in the UBP UK Online App you download to your smart device when you access the services through such device.

Strictly necessary cookies

We use specific cookies to enhance the security of UBP UK Online.

These cookies are used for both your computer and your smart device unless indicated otherwise.

Functionality cookies

We make use of cookies to provide you with certain functionality. For example, to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language or the region you are in), or to recognise the platform from which you access a site, and to provide enhanced and more personal features. These cookies are not used to track your browsing outside of UBP UK Online. UBP UK Online is not offered without the use of these cookies. If you do not consent to the use of these cookies, you will not be able to download and use the UBP UK Online App.
