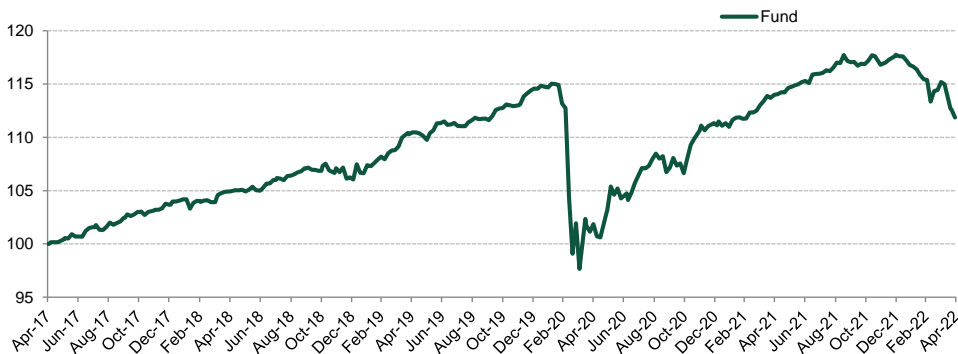

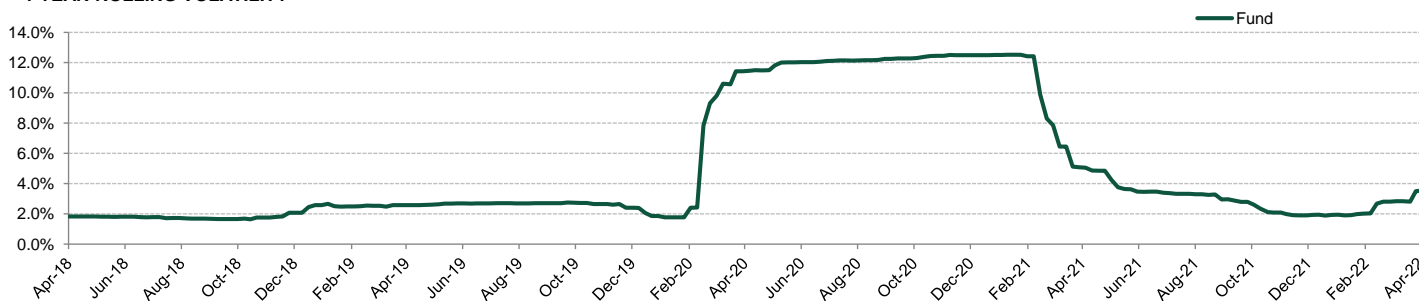

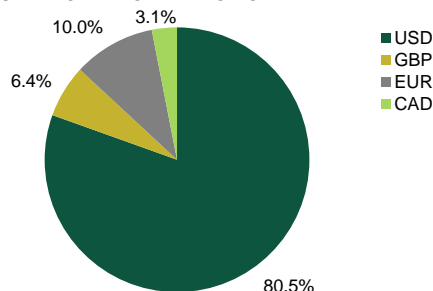

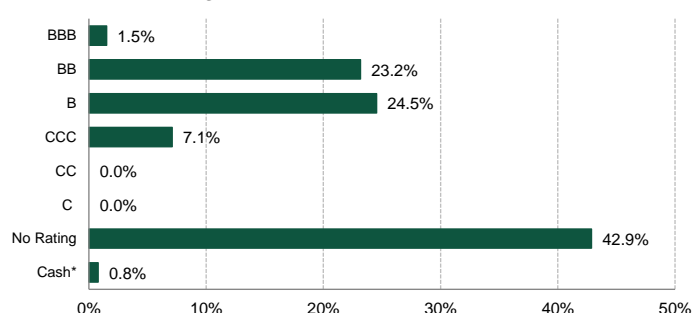

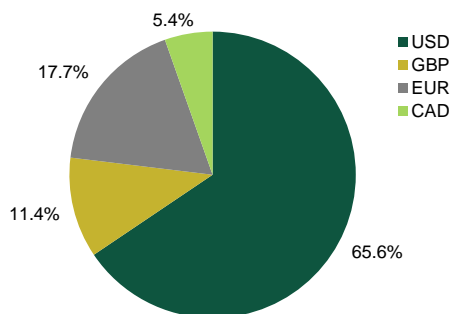

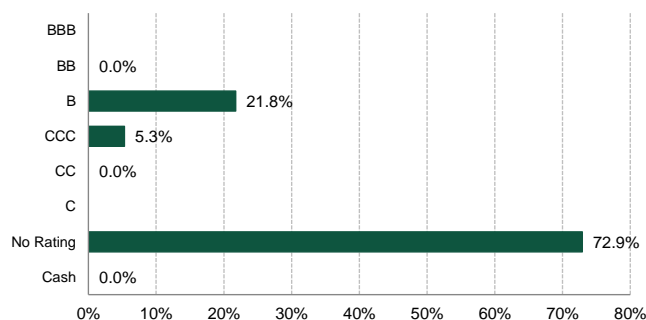

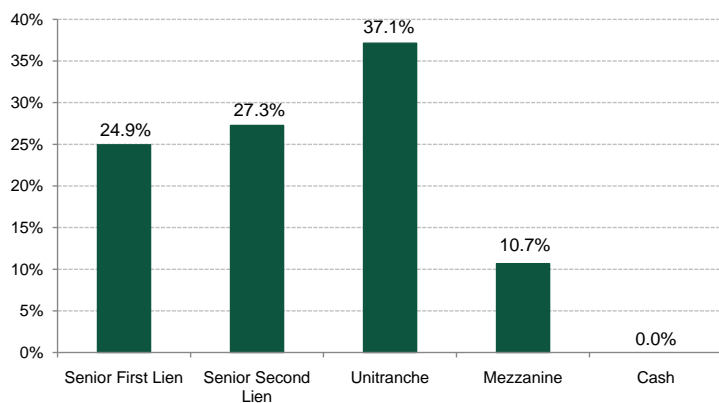

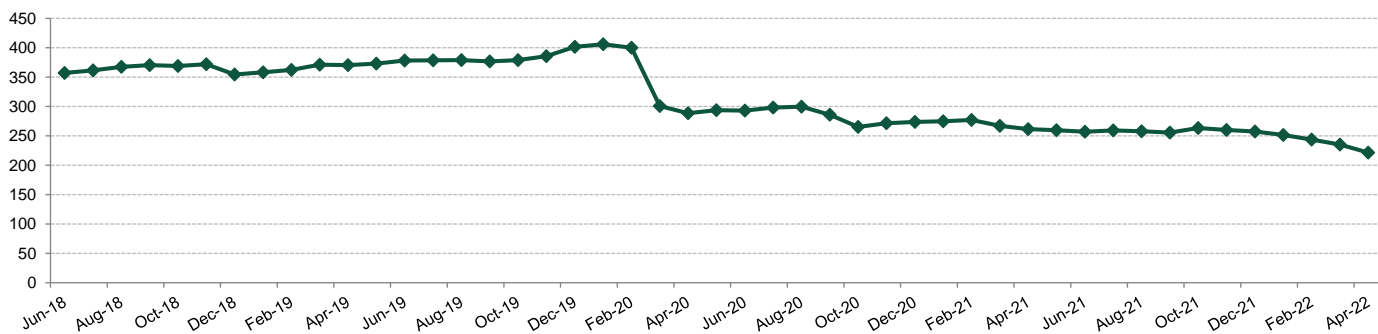

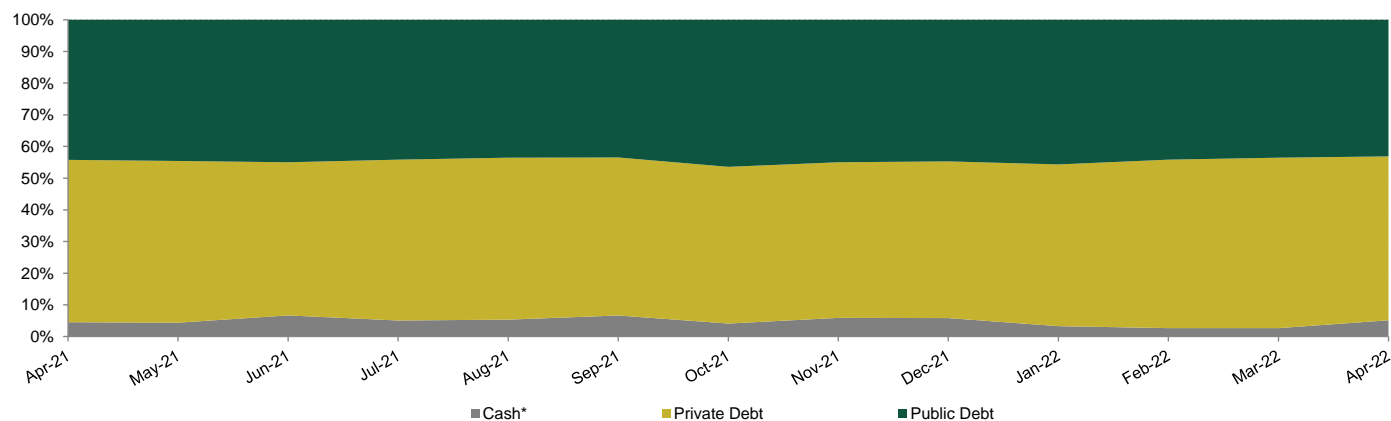
AUM
