We look to invest in a concentrated portfolio of 10 to 20 high-conviction equity funds, sourced from within the whole universe of long-only UCITS funds. The fund of funds has exposure to our four trends (climate change, demographics, consumption patterns and disruptive innovation) and gives investors enhanced access to the best managers the team has selected in each thematic.


Investment case

UBP is launching a thematic fund-of-fund investment because we believe secular trends will continue to reshape the world and financial markets. A team of experienced investment professionals selects and blends best-of-breed funds using a proprietary investment process.

Fund concept

This diversified investment solution is designed to take full advantage of long-term trends reshaping the world's economies. This fund of funds is based on the concept that the traditional industry classification framework is becoming less relevant: disruptive innovation blurs the lines between countries, sectors and industries. Innovation requires asset managers to take courageous decisions, such as launching and adapting innovative solutions in the thematic space. Investments will only be made in third-party thematic equity funds that are carefully selected using a proprietary methodology. Conviction is key in the investment team's approach, which is based on a rigorous, bottom-up process designed to select the best thematic funds. The portfolio will have between 10 and 20 funds and a low turnover rate.


Aiming at taking advantage of 4 major trends with long-term and lasting effects



Investment process

UBAM - Multifunds Secular Trends is managed according to a disciplined investment approach:

- Quantitative screening enabling the team to navigate a large universe and select the best managers, using a proprietary scoring methodology applied to risk-adjusted returns, consistency of returns, and market-capture ratios
- Qualitative analysis of a narrower set of long-only funds with a clear focus on transparency, consistency, alignment of interest and asset capacity
- Identifying and blending together skilful managers that have specific and identifiable characteristics
- Focus on best-in-class managers' alpha generation, rather than tactical asset allocation



Investment guidelines

- The Fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark
- +/- 10% sector deviation
- Holdings: 10–20 funds
- Max 10% in a single fund
