Generating high income with a typical BB risk profile UBAM - Strategic Income invests across global fixed income markets, allocating to high-income credit segments.

Investment case

BB bonds provide investors with attractive income levels whilst maintaining modest volatility. Since 31.12.1999, BB bonds have returned 7.2% annualised with a volatility of 4.1% versus the BBB segment's returns of 5.1% and a volatility of 4.0%. This demonstrates that, from a reward vs. risk perspective, BB bonds are attractive.



Fund concept

UBAM - Strategic Income's goal is to generate high income with a typical BB risk profile. The fund, which is actively managed, invests across high-income credit segments, leveraging the Global & Absolute Return Fixed Income team's bottom-up research process to select issuers from sovereign and corporate bonds to subordinated debt and securitised credit.

Performance of BB bonds and BBB bonds, total return hedged to USD



Investment process

- Each of the investable credit segments is managed within the team, leveraging the expertise of its investment professionals
- The overall allocation to the credit segments is the product of the top-down macro scenario formulated by the team and a relative value analysis of the segments against each other
- The overall allocation to the credit segments is discussed at the team's asset allocation meeting where each segment is represented
- Issuers are selected through the team's fundamental bottom-up research process
