UBAM is a SICAV managed by UBP Asset Management (Europe) S.A.

Objectives and investment policy

The Fund seeks to grow your capital and generate income primarily by investing in Swiss equities.

The Fund is actively managed and concentrated, investing mainly in securities denominated in Swiss Francs.

The Fund is focused primarily on companies with a market capitalization of between CHF 100 million and CHF 10 billion.

The ESG approach is embedded in the investment process of the sub fund and the selection of stocks include ESG criteria. ESG considerations can be an important driver for risks associated with an investment and for maintaining or improving Cash Flow Returns on Investment (CFROI) of a company.

The qualitative sustainable analysis is partly based on inputs provided by MSCI ESG Research, and on own analysis of the Investment Manager which incorporates ESG criteria in its analyses.

The Fund aims to outperform the Swiss Performance Index Extra (the "Benchmark"). The Benchmark is not representative of the Fund's risk profile and the portfolio's investments will deviate materially from the Benchmark.

The Fund's value is calculated and expressed in Swiss Francs.

Investors in the Fund can subscribe and redeem units on any business day in Luxembourg except days where the decisive market is closed: Switzerland (CH).

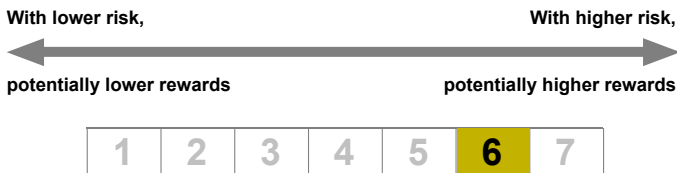

Risk and reward profile



This indicator represents the annual historical volatility of the Fund over a 5-year period.

This is due to investments in small cap equities on the Swiss market.

Counterparty risk: As the Fund uses over-the-counter derivatives, there is a risk that the counterparty to the transactions will wholly or partially fail to honour its contractual obligations. This may result in a financial loss to the Fund.

Currency risk: The Fund invests in overseas markets. It can be affected by changes in exchange rates which may cause the value of your investment to decrease or increase.

Liquidity risk: Liquidity risk exists when particular investments are difficult to purchase or sell. This can reduce the Fund's returns because the Fund may be unable to transact at advantageous times or prices.

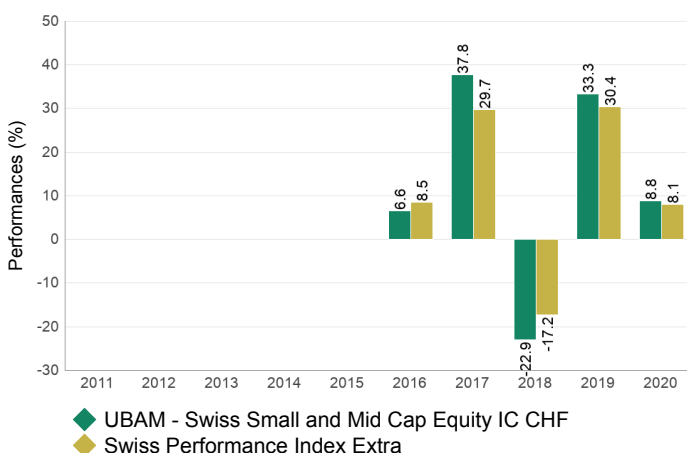
