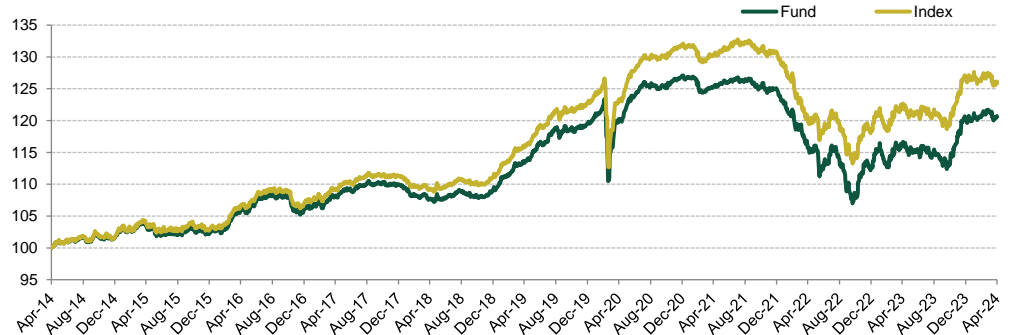

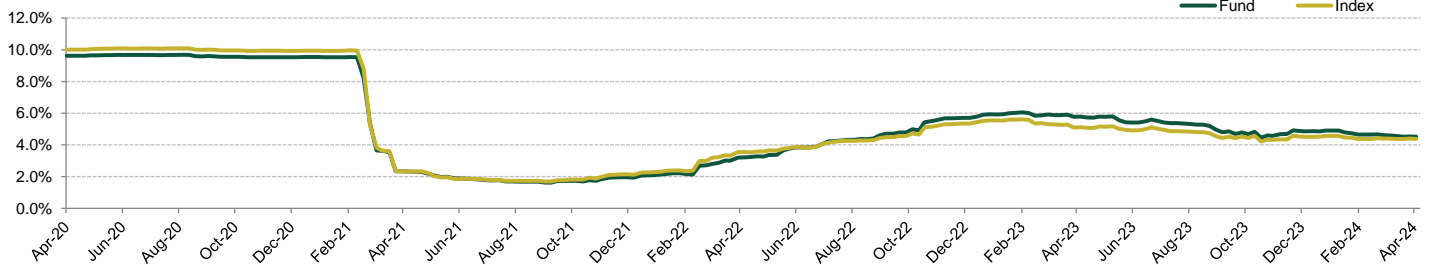
10-YEAR TRACK RECORD *

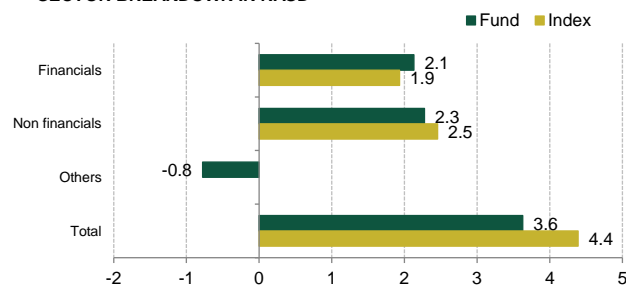

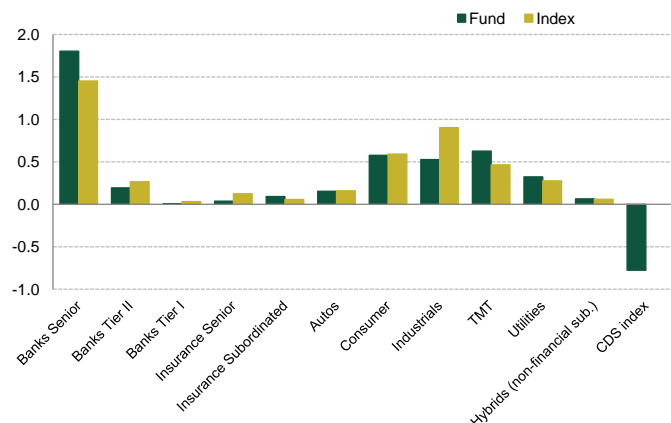

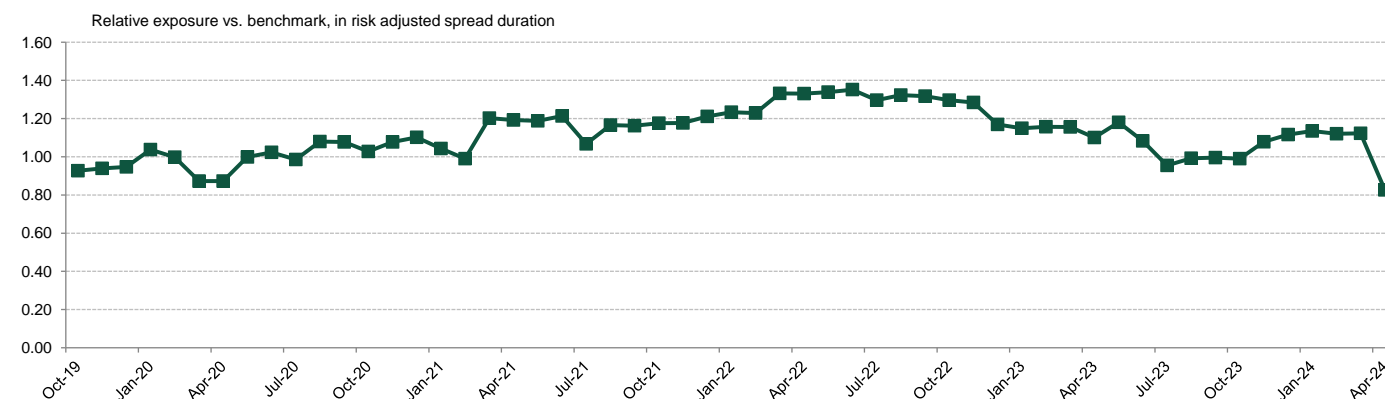

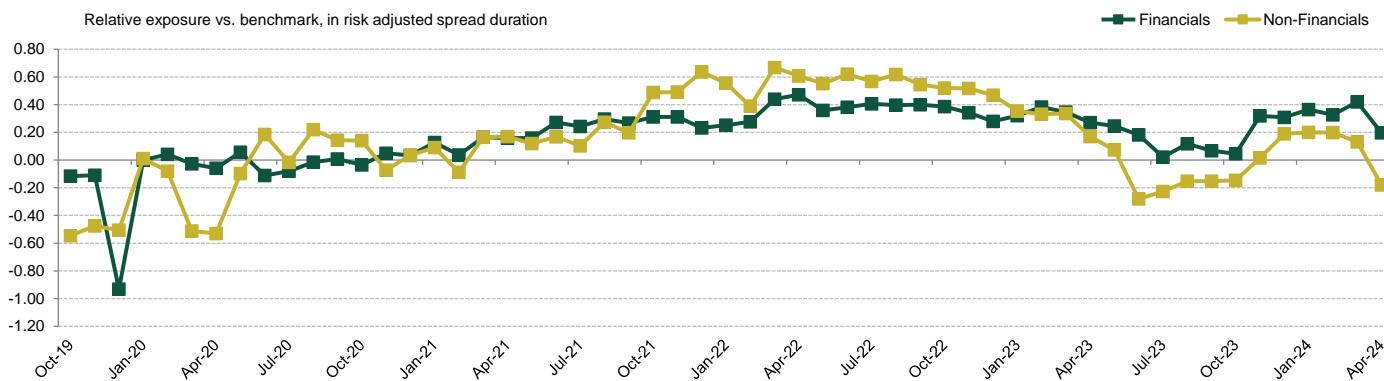

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APPENDIX

◆ **ESG Rating**

The ESG Rating is derived from ESG Quality Score. The score is mapped to a seven-letter scale: best (AAA) to worst (CCC). The ESG Quality Score is mapped to a Letter Rating as follows: [8.6, 10] -> AAA; [7.1, 8.6] -> AA; [5.7, 7.1] -> A; [4.3, 5.7] -> BBB; [2.9, 4.3] -> BB; [1.4, 2.9] -> B; [0, 1.4] -> CCC.

◆ **ESG Quality Score**

The ESG Quality Score represents either the ESG Ratings Final Industry-Adjusted Score or Government Adjusted ESG Score of the issuer. ESG Ratings indicate how well an issuer manages its most material ESG risks relative to sector peers. Government Ratings indicates overall environmental, social, and governance (ESG) performance of a region. While the three underlying scores (Environmental, Social, Governance) are absolute scores, the ESG Quality Score is relative to industry/regional peers and thus cannot be easily deducted from the three underlying scores.

◆ **Environmental Score**

The ESG Environmental Score represents either the Intangible Value Assessment (IVA) Environmental Pillar Score or Government Rating Environmental Pillar Score of the issuer. The score indicates how well an issuer manages its environmental issues. Score ranges from 0-10. The Environmental Pillar Score represents the weighted average of all Key Issues that fall under the Environment Pillar.

◆ **Social Score**

The ESG Social Score represents either the Intangible Value Assessment (IVA) Social Pillar Score or Government Rating Social Pillar Score of the issuer. The score indicates how well an issuer manages its social issues. Score ranges from 0-10. The Social Pillar Score represents the weighted average of all Key Issues that fall under the Social Pillar.

◆ **Governance Score**

The ESG Governance Score represents either the Intangible Value Assessment (IVA) Governance Pillar Score or Government Rating Governance Pillar Score of the issuer. The score indicates how well an issuer manages its governance issues. Score ranges from 0-10. The Governance Pillar Score represents the weighted average of all Key Issues that fall under the Governance Pillar.
