The Fund seeks to grow your capital and generate income by investing primarily in equities or equivalent issued by companies in the European Union, in the United Kingdom, in the European Economic Area and/or in Switzerland.

The Fund is actively managed, invested around 30 positions and focused on large market capitalization and leading companies in their particular business fields, which are expected to provide growth and leading (i.e. sustainably high quality) levels of Cash Flow Return on Investment (CFROI® Credit Suisse HOLT).

The Fund is long-term oriented with little need for turnover.

The Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) approach is embedded in the investment process of the Fund and the selection of stocks includes ESG considerations which can be an important driver for risks associated with an investment and for maintaining or improving CFROI® of a company.


SECTOR COMPARISON
